



As Chairman of Grant County I would like to thank the BLM for the thorough Draft Environmental Impact Statement and desire to support your findings and suggested route for the SunZia electrical transmission lines. We are aware of several companies who have an interest with building both solar and wind generation in Grant County. New Mexico has the wind needed to attract generation companies and southwest New Mexico has some of the best solar available. Without new electrical lines we do not have capacity in our existing transmission lines to export these valuable resources and create employment and needed revenue.
